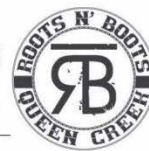

Roots N' Boots Queen Creek 2018 Sweetheart Guidelines

Intent:

The intent of Roots N' Boots Queen Creek Sweethearts is to give younger girls the opportunity to “shadow” queen title holders and see what it is like to be a Rodeo Queen. By shadowing our queens, we hope that it will give younger girls an insight to what it is like to be a queen, what is expected from them and their parents and most of all gives them the experience needed to then move forward one day and become a rodeo royalty queen. The hope is that these young ladies will learn from current queens how to interact with people, how to speak to people and how to serve their communities.

Process:

- Information will be posted on all social media, emailed and posted on the RnB website starting November 1, 2017.
- Deadline for the applications must be submitted to the Sweetheart Coordinator by November 27, 2017.
- Basic information required will be: Name, Address, Age, Parent Information, along with a picture.
- All applicants will be reviewed by Sweetheart Coordinators and a final determination will be proposed to the RnB Board by the December board meeting.
- 7-12 Sweethearts will be chosen between the ages of 6-11 years old(by application due date) to be part of the 2018 RnB Royalty Court.
- A \$40.00 fee will be required from all selected Sweetheart Royalty.

What will Sweethearts Receive?

- RnB Sash
- RnB Tiara

What is expected from Sweethearts?

- Participation at all events and functions during Roots N' Boots Rodeo week (4 days) is a requirement.
- Participation in the Town of Queen Creek Founders Day Celebration, Trunk or Treat, Town of Queen Creek Holiday Parade and Block Party events is a high priority. Other Town of Queen Creek events are not required but are open for participation.
- Participation in any fundraising efforts from time of announcement (approximately January 2018) through end of their reign (December 2018)
- There will be no riding at events and no expectation if they can ride or have a horse.
- Each Sweetheart is expected to have an adult at every event to supervise. The care and supervision of each participant belongs to that adult.
