Collected 426 Surveys in 2018
*96 Surveys from Friday
*291 Surveys from Saturday

Data Collected Represents Information on 2,131 attendees.

Data collection point:
*In 2018 \& 2017 surveys were collected primarily during the day at the Chick-Fil-A booth. In previous years many surveys were collected immediately following the rodeo by primarily youth volunteers.

## Ratings

*Only 18 of the 426 people who completed a survey rated the event "OK"
*No one rated the event "Fair" or "No Fun at All" in 2018
*408 attendees rates the event "Excellent" or "Good"

## Family Rodeo

*One third of the "OK" ratings came from families attending Kids N'
Kritters. Remember:(30\% of attendees of Roots $N^{\prime}$ Boots said Family activities were their favorite and $51 \%$ of those specifically named Kids N' Kritters as their favorite Roots N' Boots activity. So although low ratings from some, this is still one of our most popular and much loved weekend events.)
*All said better organization of lines was their complaint

*Better signage and more newspaper ads were suggested.
*Better carnival rides for teens and addition of a mechanical bull suggestions for improvement on surveys with low rating.
